U.S. HOUSE DEMOCRATS CALL FOR INCREASED FUNDING FOR CLEAN WATER AND DRINKING WATER STATE SRF'S

Last week, Congressman Peter DeFazio (D-OR) Ranking Democrat Member of the House Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure and Congressman Frank Pallone (D-NJ) Ranking Democrat Member of the House Committee on Energy and Commerce sent a letter signed by 96 Democrats to the House Appropriations Committee Leadership, requesting critical funding to protect drinking water and repair failing water infrastructure systems. The House Democrat Leaders are requesting that the fiscal year 2017 Interior Appropriations bill includes a minimum of \$2 billion for the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (Clean Water SRF) and \$2 billion for the Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (Drinking Water SRF).

Congressmen Pallone and DeFazio were joined by Ranking Democrat Member of the Subcommittee on Water Resources and Environment Grace Napolitano (D-CA), Ranking Member of the Subcommittee on Environment and the Economy, Paul Tonko (D-NY), and 92 other Democrats in requesting the critical funding.
